TRLC SPECIAL ACCOMPLISHMENTS IN 2025:

PROPERTY STEWARDSHIP

- Held 31 work parties on 20 properties. 550 volunteer hours.
- Continuing hemlock tree preservation efforts along local waterways.
- Installing signs on larger properties.

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT WITH NATURE

- Created and dedicated new Notable Tree Trail at Hawk Hill Farm in Bloomfield.
- Completed woodland restoration project at Wojan Woods in West Hartford.
- Planted pollinator garden at tiny Clark Preserve in West Hartford.
- Led multiple hikes in all towns.
- Participated in Earth Day Clean ups.
- Received Fred D. Parker Memorial Beautification Award from Windsor Chamber of Commerce.
